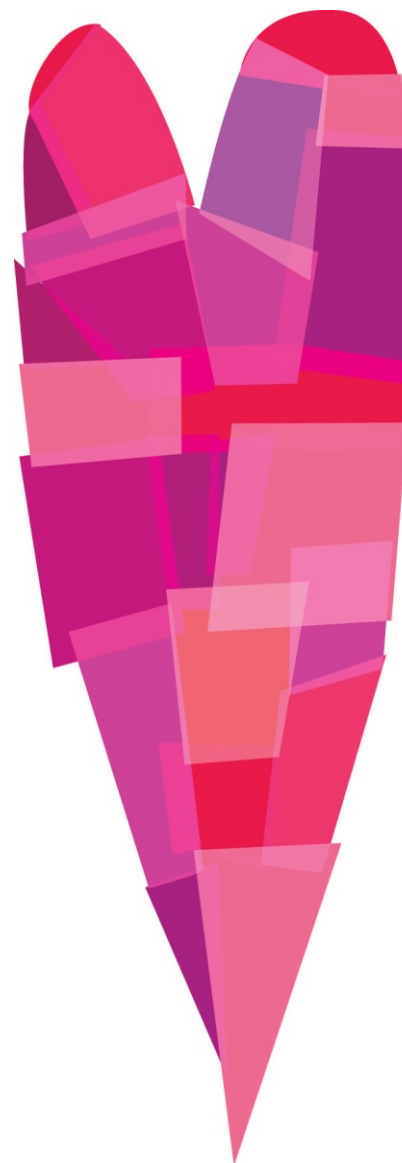

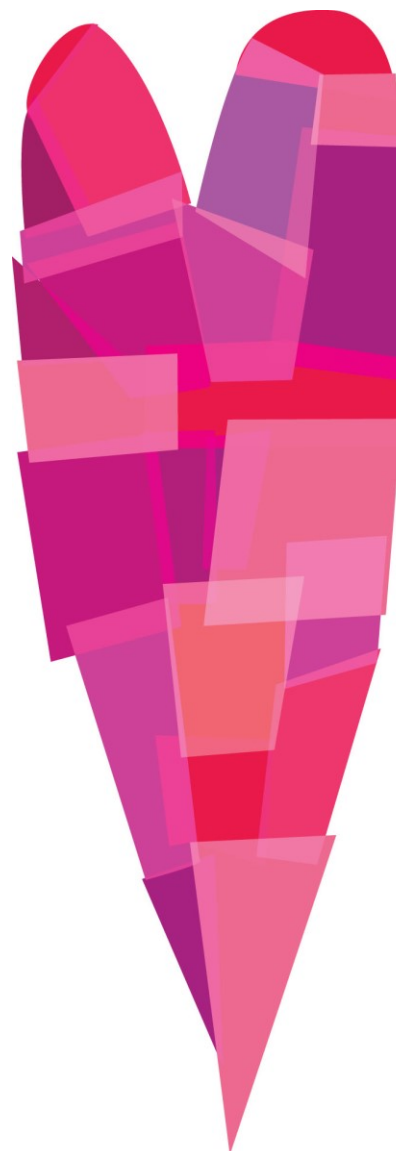

ASP Mission Trip: One of our outreach mission projects that we, at Trinity, do each year is a trip to Appalachia, more specifically Wyoming County, to a little place called Guyan Valley, West Virginia. It sits deep in the coal mining country where residents earn low or no income, and conditions are hard to believe to one who has not been there. Should you have a few minutes in front of your computer visit ASPHome.org and see what is happening there or talk with a person who has gone on the trip previously. We will leave early Wednesday morning on October 4th and drive several hours arriving about 4 pm. After settling in to our bunks and debriefing the center will have dinner for us. The next two days are a repeat of the previous day! Then Sunday morning we are up early, begin our drive home with an underway breakfast stop at our favorite Cracker Barrel in Beckley, WV.
